Special Projects – The Book Bags are here. They ended up costing \$3.34 each due to a shipping charge of \$52.40 and a set up fee of \$40. We will be selling them at the Book Sale for \$10. They will also be displayed in the library.

SRC Library Advisory Board – Nothing to report.
